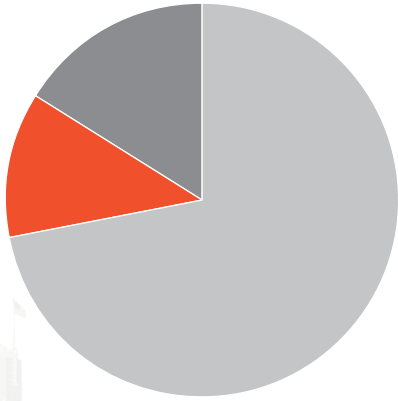


OUR STEWARDSHIP

WHAT WE DO



SEARCH + RESCUE
teams build relationships and bring essentials, resources, and hope to people on the streets.

offer meals, warm beds, and case management to help people stabilize and take the next steps toward a new life.



LONG-TERM RECOVERY
programs provide tools, counseling, and support to heal and break free from addiction.

offers lifelong support for graduates through community groups, life skills training, education, and more.
